a. As a possible alternative to towing, a request was made on June 18<sup>th</sup> to meet with Premier Booting Services.

Status: No change, on hold. Met with Premier, as well as, Parking Network Strategies, on July 2, 2013. Received the ok from the SL Attorney that services can be utilized, if deemed appropriate. Was going to prepare a meeting with SC for review, but will determine next actions after Parking Committee meetings in case current Parking Regulations require modification. I recommended that this service be reviewed for use in Sapphire Shores.

b. Daron Fitch is holding meetings with a group to discuss current Parking concerns.

Status: Daron presented his findings to the Master Board; implementation of findings scheduled for implementation in 2015.

  - At the last Presidents' Meeting on June 23<sup>rd</sup>, a request was made to add a message to the Security Officers' phones, prior to the officers answering, that would suggest that a resident call 911 if the call is an emergency.
    - This is important in that valuable time is wasted with the extra communication loop.
    - The details of the call to 911 could be wrong if the message is incorrect/misunderstood.
    - o It's understood that the reason some residents would prefer to call FPI first is that, should the situation be a 'non-issue' after an investigation, that might be cause for embarrassment for the resident. It shouldn't be. Residents, FPI, and the police departments, all working together, 'make it happen' and it's always better to be safe than sorry.
    - PPM (Robert) will be working with Verizon to add the message, which a
      resident will hear prior to the officer taking the call. No feedback as of this
      writing.
