*Top 5 Ways to help Improve Water Quality in Our Lakes*



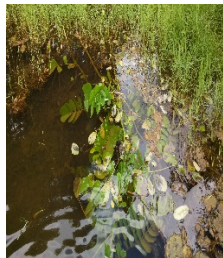
Keep Backyards free of debris and trash that will blow or be thrown into the lake.



Keep Grass Clippings out of the Water! Mowers and weed eaters should be used in an Eco-friendly manner to minimize the grass clippings discharged into the lake.



Don't blow the grass clippings into the street. Rainfall and sprinkler runoff washes them right down the street drain into the lake.



Don't throw anything in the street drains! It's illegal and considered pollution. There is nothing other than rain water that is allowed to go down the street drain.

Fertilization: When applying fertilizer in the backyard, don't apply anything on the slope down to the lake. Stop on the flat part of the yard just short of the slope. In the front yard, be careful not to fertilize on the street and when finished blow any fertilizer off the street and sidewalks back into the yard.

Please Don't feed the ducks. They are scavengers and eat an all-natural diet of different algae, bugs and worms of all sorts. Excessive feeding leads to over-population and eventually disease and death. One or two ducks is nice 100 ducks is a pollution generator. Your lakes are not designed to feed lots for duck production.
